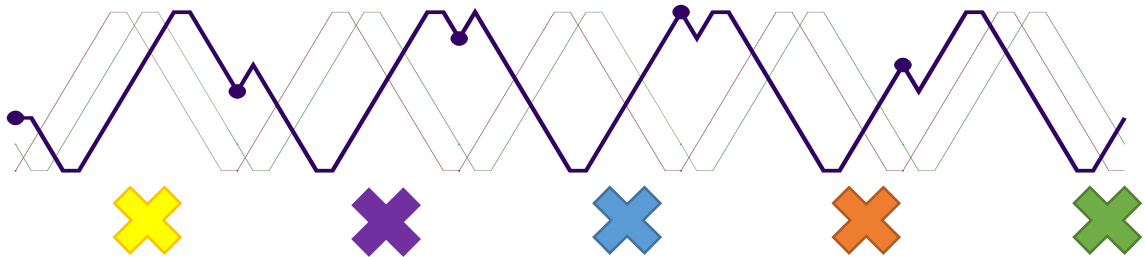







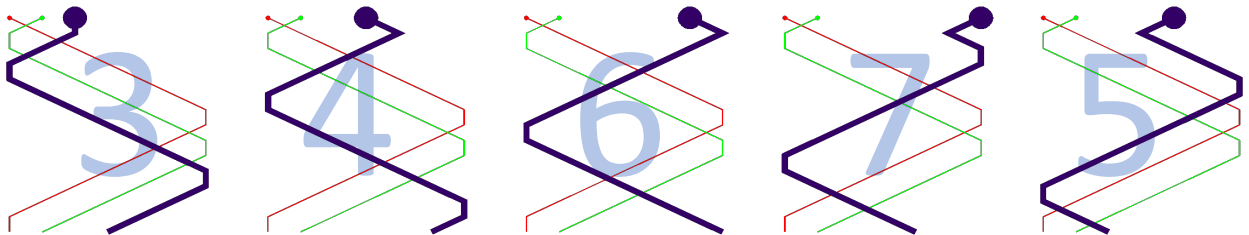
Grandsire Triples



The dodges in Grandsire Triples are either in 4/5 or 6/7 like Stedman Triples (but not like Plain Bob which are 3/4 and 5/6). Just like Grandsire doubles, there is a second **hunt bell** which goes in and out of the method. It always goes into the method on the way down from the back with a double dodge 5/4 down at a call. The new hunt bell goes into the hunt after it takes the treble off lead.

- Rules:
-  Pass the treble in **2nd** place Make 3rds and back in to lead
 -  Pass the treble in **3rd** place Dodge **4/5 UP**
 -  Pass the treble in **4th** place Dodge **6/7 UP**
 -  Pass the treble in **5th** place Hunt up, lie, Dodge **7/6 DOWN** and go in
 -  Pass the treble in **6th** place Hunt up, Lie, Dodge **5/4 DOWN** and go in

If you haven't passed the treble at this point you are in the hunt, so remember no dodging!



Bobs and Singles

- The bells in the first 3 places do exactly what you would do for a bob or a single of Grandsire Doubles
- If you **take the treble off lead** you **become the hunt bell** so you plain hunt until the next call
- The **hunt bell double dodges 5/4 down** and goes into the method.
- The bell going into 5ths place double dodges and goes up to the back and then in to lead
- The bell in 6th place double dodges 6/7, lies behind and goes in to lead
- The bell lying in 7th place double dodges 7/6 down and goes in to lead
